MANUFACTURING TEAM LEAD

Employment: Full Time | Reports To: Production Manager | Location: Poole's Corner, PEI

ABOUT THE ROLE

The Manufacturing Team Lead assists management with the planning, coordination and control of manufacturing processes. As the leader of the shop, the Team Lead is the main contact for Manufacturing Technicians and is responsible for the coordination of employee activities including work priorities and employee tasks/assignments. The Manufacturing Team Lead is responsible for the Quality, Health, Safety and ensuring that environment regulatory requirements are met.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES MANUFACTURING

- · Reading and interpreting schematics, blueprints, and electrical code specifications.
- · Assist with setup and testing of completed project builds.
- · Review build packages, print wire tags, and print component labels.
- Test electronic and electrical components and equipment for voltage, resistance, continuity and current.
- · Follow manufacturing processes and quality policies.

COORDINATE EMPLOYEE ACTIVITIES

- Determines the priorities for work to be done, sometimes based on their own initiative and authority, but more often based on needs communicated by management.
- · Determines the required skills and number of technicians appropriate for the job, and verifies that needed material is available.
- If problems arise, the Team Lead may alter the schedule to minimize downtime (or overtime) or may assign workers to another project if appropriate.

HANDLE PERSONNEL FUNCTIONS

- · Documents workers' performance and is involved in performance reviews and/ or providing input to the Manufacturing
- Provides feedback on training needs for the workers.
- The Team Lead is typically the timekeeper for the manufacturing group. He/She may be required to prepare consolidated time reports for payroll, approve time cards or enter hours worked into a time record system.

ACT AS SAFETY COORDINATOR

- Ensures that workers obey all safety regulations.
- Is responsible for communicating safety procedures to employees and providing safety training to new workers.
- · Inspects the work environment or equipment to verify that no hazardous conditions exist.
- · Conducts regular safety meetings and conducts safety drills to ensure every employee is familiar with safety and evacuation procedures and knows what to do in emergency situations.
- In the event of an accident, the Team Lead is responsible for preparation of the preliminary incident report.

OTHER DUTIES

- Oversees inventory control in tracking/ maintaining inventory and initiating requisitions for needed supplies.
- Prepares production progress reports for management.
- · Schedules downtime for routine and preventative maintenance.
- · Provides estimates to management on production output.
- Responsible for construction training for new workers.
- Assists Quality Control Inspector to ensure that workflow and inspections are synergized.
- · Be the preliminary contact for workrelated issues that technicians may have, such as requests to take leave time.
- Provide feedback regarding continuous improvement to process and company culture.
